Senate Stimulus Vote Is Today

The Senate has scheduled the vote on the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act for today following final debate. It appears that there will be 60 votes for the measure. There may be a final attempt to increase funding for wastewater and drinking water. Last week the attempt failed by only 2 votes.

Working with the Water Infrastructure Network (WIN), our Coalition has urged House and Senate members who will be on the Conference Committee (the House and Senate bills being different requires a Conference Committee that merges the bills) to increase the final funding for wastewater and drinking water.

Although I will be away on a trip this week and part of next week, I will work with former Congressman Roe and Sante Esposito to provide you with updates on final action.
