Save the Date: Tuesday, April 14 – Thursday, April 16, 2026

Join CWCC in Washington, DC for Water Week 2026!

Coalition members will:

- **Advocate for water infrastructure funding and policy solutions with their federal representatives**
- **Receive briefings from Current Strategies, congressional stakeholders, and federal agency officials on the status of water infrastructure policy decisions in DC**
- **Network with fellow coalition members and other water sector stakeholders working in DC and around the country**

Tentative Schedule:

- Tuesday 4/14: National Water Policy Fly-In (optional)
 - Half-day afternoon conference hosted by water utility associations.
 - Keynote speakers/panel discussions followed by a networking happy hour, widely attended by water infrastructure professionals based in DC and across the country.
 - Registration is set to open in mid-December; cost is expected to be \$150.
- Wednesday 4/15: CWCC meeting/exclusive programming
 - Morning: flexible timing for a potential meeting with the EPA Office of Water, additional meetings with congressional delegations, etc.
 - Afternoon: lunch, hybrid coalition meeting, guest speakers from Congress or federal agencies, and Hill meeting best practices presentation from Current Strategies. Group happy hour or dinner to follow.
- Thursday 4/16: Meetings on Capitol Hill
 - As group schedules permit, all-day meetings on Capitol Hill with coalition members' lawmakers/staff.
 - Folders of CWCC-branded materials will be provided; Current Strategies is available to schedule all meetings on behalf of coalition members.

We are excited for you to join us! The week presents an excellent opportunity to liaise with peers across the water sector, and to build invaluable relationships with policymakers in Congress who are key to setting water infrastructure policies that can have a huge impact on the delivery of construction projects. Your visit will come at a time when Congress is negotiating both appropriations bills (to fund water programs) and authorizing bills (to set program rules and create new funding mechanisms).
